Empire State Youth Orchestras' (ESYO) 300 + members come from the Capital Region of New York and western New England. They must audition each year for a position in one of ESYO's nine performing groups, including the Repertory Orchestra. Collectively, these groups give about 30 public performances each year, including Melodies of Christmas, an annual free concert for senior citizens, and concerts for young people. ESYO's program also includes a music education program that provides free, private music lessons to inner-city youth in Albany and Schenectady. Founded in 1979, ESYO has been recognized as a premier music education/performance program for youth and has received three prestigious national awards from ASCAP.
